DIRECTOR, ADVANCED EDUCATION PROGRAM IN PROSTHODONTICS**

The Ohio State University College of Dentistry is seeking a Director of the Advanced Education Program in Prosthodontics. This is a full-time clinical track or tenured appointment. For tenure appointment, candidates must demonstrate a sustained outstanding record in teaching and research.

The Ohio State University College of Dentistry is the third largest public dental school in the United States, and it is the only public dental school in Ohio. The college is divided into eight sections or academic units. All major ADA-recognized dental specialties are represented. The primary area of responsibility of this faculty position will be to direct all aspects of the advanced prosthodontic program following current CODA accreditation standards. Applicants must be board certified by the American Board of Prosthodontics, a graduate of a CODA accredited advanced education program in prosthodontics, and eligible for licensure by the Ohio Board of Dentistry. Preference will be given to candidates with broad clinical expertise in prosthodontics, prior experience in dental education, advanced degrees, research accomplishments, or leadership in organized prosthodontics. The selected candidate will participate in the intramural faculty practice.

Evaluation of applicants will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Salary and academic rank are commensurate with qualifications.
