



## **Orthodontic Graduate Program Director**

The Ohio State University College of Dentistry is seeking a candidate for a full-time, clinical or tenure track position as the Orthodontic Graduate Program Director in the Division of Orthodontics. The appointment will be at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor.

The Ohio State University College of Dentistry is the third largest public dental school in the United States, and it is the only public dental school in Ohio. The college is divided into eight sections or academic units. All major clinical dental specialties are represented. The primary area of responsibility of the faculty position includes leading the Graduate Orthodontic program and will participate in the section's teaching, research and patient care programs. Preference will be given to applicants with demonstrated expertise in clinical care, scholarship and program administration. This appointment potentially could lead to Director of the Division's graduate clinic.

Required qualifications include a D.M.D., D.D.S. degree, or equivalent and advanced training in Orthodontics and ABO Board certification. Applicants must be eligible for licensure in Ohio. Academic rank and salary will be based on the candidate's qualifications and experience. An intramural practice opportunity is available.
